...to the ABC Bel Canto Choirs! You and your child are in for a very exciting experience this year. Please read each section of this booklet carefully, so you will be aware of the expectations for participation in our program.

ABC Bel Canto's mission is to develop within the children of WNY a love of high-quality choral music through performance. Our choristers work to increase their skill and musicianship while developing a fine vocal tradition. ABC choristers experience a variety of music and enjoy musical growth in their many special concert performances in varied venues.

The Choir was founded in 1994 by Sue Fay Allen to sing for a single concert alongside a local adult community choir. Since then, ABC has grown from the original 25 singers to over 120 choristers from 30 different schools. **Presto** is for children grades 3-6, **Vivace** for treble voices grades 6-12, and **Bravo** for changed male voices and high school women.

REHEARSALS

Rehearsals are held on Thursdays from September to May:

Presto 4:30 – 5:30pm

Vivace 6:00 – 7:30pm

Bravo 7:30 – 8:45pm

All rehearsals are held in the Fellowship Hall of Christ United Methodist Church unless otherwise announced.

CUMC is located on the corner of Harlem and Saratoga in Amherst.

Expectations

- Be 5-10 minutes early to each rehearsal.
- Please do not touch the piano.
- Bring a pencil and your music folder every week.
- No gum, candy, food, or CELL PHONES allowed in the rehearsal room.

Attendance Policy

Any chorister who accumulates excessive unexcused absences may be asked to leave the Choir. No tuition refunds will be issued for a student who must resign from ABC for attendance reasons.

To receive an excused absence, families must contact Sue Fay Allen *prior* to the missed event. She can be reached by email (suefayca@localnet.com), phone (759-6428) or at the ABC Attendance Line (480-2618). ***If you are calling the same day as a rehearsal, performance, or event, you MUST use the ABC Attendance Line.***

In addition, any chorister who misses the rehearsal immediately prior to a performance will not sing in that concert.

Voice Placement

All members will perform a voice screening each year for appropriate section placement.

CONCERTS

Expectations

- Be 5-10 minutes early for concert call time. This is usually a half-hour before the concert starts.
- Wear the concert dress appropriate for your choir (see “UNIFORMS”, next page)
- Vivace and Bravo members must bring their hardback concert folder (with music!)
- No perfume, cologne, or body spray
- No gum, candy, food, or CELL PHONES allowed
- Appropriate concert etiquette is expected at all times

Etiquette

- No talking during any part of a performance
- Applaud when appropriate; refrain from stomping, shouting, or calling out
- Follow adult instructions immediately—both from teachers and parent volunteers

**please use discretion when deciding whether to bring a baby or very young child along with you to a concert. Our concerts are all professionally recorded (each chorister receives a CD included with tuition), and audience noise can be very disruptive to a recording.*

**please refrain from flash photography during performances.*

please do not **ever post any ABC video or photo to YouTube or any other public website. This violates copyright agreements that we have with the music publishers and we could be sued and/or heavily fined.*

TUITION, MUSIC, & UNIFORMS

Tuition

Tuition is different for each choir, and goes towards our many expenses: music, folders, uniforms, maintenance, recordings, venue fees, insurance, travel costs, salaries, guest musicians, and clinicians.

Each chorister receives a T-shirt at camp and a CD at the end of the season.

Vivace \$325

Bravo \$275

Vivace & Bravo \$375

A half-tuition payment is due by June 1st each year, with the balance due by the last week of August. A one-time \$25 fee is assessed when a child initially joins the choir to cover the cost of music and potential uniform damage. Tuition Assistance Grants are available based on need, but there is a minimum tuition payment of \$25 regardless of grants. There is also a discount of \$25 for each additional member of your family (beyond the first) who sings with ABC.

Music

Each chorister is assigned a number, which goes with the number marked on all of his/her music. The music is surprisingly expensive—so take good care of it! **Use only pencil to mark your music.** Lost or damaged music will be billed to the chorister.

Uniforms

Presto: Please purchase a **white, long-sleeved, button-down oxford shirt with a collar** and **black dress slacks**. All choristers will wear their shirts tucked in with a red bow tie loaned from the choir. **Black socks** and **flat, black shoes** are also required.

Vivace: All members will be measured and purchase a tuxedo shirt through our vendor—which runs about \$15. The shirt will be tucked into the chorister's own **black dress pants** and worn with **black socks/stockings** and **FLAT, black, closed-toe shoes**. Vivace members will be issued a vest from the choir, which must be returned at the end of the season.

Bravo: All members of Bravo will be measured and purchase a tuxedo shirt through our vendor—which runs about \$15. The shirt will be tucked into the chorister's own **black dress pants** and worn with **black socks/stockings** and **FLAT, black, closed-toe shoes**. Ladies will be issued a shawl and gentlemen will receive a bow tie and cummerbund which must be returned at the end of the season.

Replacement Costs:

The following costs will be billed to a chorister for lost or damaged items:

Vest, Cummerbund, or Shawl	\$50.00 each
Concert Folder	\$20.00 each
Bow Tie	\$10.00 each
Music	\$5.00 per piece

Refunds

100% of tuition is refundable if a chorister withdraws from the Choir **before the first rehearsal**.

80% is refunded if a chorister withdraws **by September 30th**.

No refunds will be given after September 30th.

FUNDRAISING

We hold several fundraisers each year to help support our overall operations and keep the cost of tuition as reasonable as possible. We also need to raise funds to cover the increasing need for Tuition Assistance Grants among our membership. Fundraising ideas generated by the Staff, Board, and individual choir parents help achieve these goals. We also work with Giving Assistant, are members of Amazon Smile, and use iGive.com to raise additional revenue. We rely on volunteer assistance to run these fundraisers and make them successful, and hope that every family can do their part to help ensure the future of ABC.

COMMUNICATION

Email

We send a weekly email to all our families with information, reminders, changes, and any other important events that may occur. ***It is extremely important that you read this email each week.*** If you change your email address, please contact Laura Biddle at amherstbelcanto@gmail.com immediately to make sure you continue to receive this important communication. We encourage older choristers to provide their email addresses as well, so they can be more involved in the details of Choir work.

If you do not have access to email, you will not receive these weekly informational bulletins. Please let us know so that we can be sure to contact you by phone for important, emergency notifications.

ABC respects your privacy and will not use this email list for anything other than the exchange of Choir-related messages.
